

2010+ CAMARO STRUT COVERS

INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS (FOR PART#'s CA-280001-BL, -BLK, -RD)

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TOOLS NEEDED FOR INSTALLATION

- Strut Rod Nut 24mm Socket (Available from Drake P/N CA-7544-SOCKET or OTC 7544)
- 1/2" Drive Ratchet
- 1/2" Drive Torque Wrench
- 3" Extension
- T-50 Torx Socket
- · Small flat head screw driver

2010 CAMARO STRUT COVER INSTALLATION

- 1. Place car on level ground, open hood and locate the strut caps.
- Remove plastic nut covers by twisting counterclockwise. Use the strut rod nut socket on the nut while holding the strut rod with T-50 torx socket to prevent rotating. Remove strut nut. Repeat for both sides.
- 3. Remove the rubber rings around factory strut caps and install on new Drake strut covers.
- 4. Pop off strut cover cap by carefully inserting a flat head screw driver into the slot and prying upward.
- 5. Install Drake strut cover. Re-use factory nut and torque to 49 ft-lbs using the strut rod nut socket and T-50 torx to hold the rod. (**Figure 1 & 2**)
- 6. Install strut cover cap by pushing on it until it snaps in place. (some light oil on the o-ring will help if cap doesn't sit flush). **(Figure 3)**

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
