# **REMOVAL INSTRUCTIONS**

FACTORY PCV LINE



1. Remove engine cover by using a flathead screwdriver to remove the caps, revealing the bolt and nuts. Use a 10mm wrench to remove the nuts. Once nuts are removed, pull the engine cover off the 4 mounting points to remove the cover from the vehicle.



2. Remove stock PCV Line from vehicle by pulling on the tab on the 2 quick disconnect fittings.

This concludes removal instructions.




## **INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS**





 Use an 8mm Wrench to remove the bolt located next to the passenger side shock tower. Insert the Catch Can bracket and reinstall the 8mm bolt to secure bracket.

Insert barbed elbow fittings into the catch can.
 IMPORTANT: Corsa recommends using thread sealant or PTFE tape on barbed fittings and bottom drain plug to prevent any leaks.



3. Install the catch can on to the bracket the 4mm Hex Screws and the 2.5mm Allen Wrench. Attach Hose A to the "A" side of the catch can and route it to the fitting closest to the catch can. Attach Hose B to the "B" side of the catch can and route to the fitting located further from the catch can.



This concludes installation instructions.

Check that this catch can complies with your Federal, State and Local laws.

We recommend saving your stock PCV line.

#### **BEFORE ROAD TESTING**

- 1. Start engine, leaving the transmission in park and securing the parking brake.
- 2. Make sure to look and listen for any unusual noises or air leaks. Repair problems if needed.
- **3.** Once completed it will be necessary to check periodically, after a few heat cycles, for realignment and tightening of all connections.

**EMPTYING CATCH CAN:** Twist off the bottom of the catch can and dump captured oil back into engine or dispose of it. It is recommended to check and empty the catch can with every oil change.
